**Guidelines For ONSITE Voting**

**General Body Voting**

- #1 **ALL VOTERS must** be registered with the General Body for the **March 2022 & June 2022** council sessions. *\* Voters will not be able to register for March 2022 at the June 2022 council session.*
- #2 **ALL VOTERS must** be a member of the council and possess a NDC Membership Card (CURRENT 2020-2022). *\* Voters cannot purchase current card at June 2022 council session.*

**Auxiliary Voting**

- #1 **ALL VOTERS must** be registered with the General Body for the **March 2022 & June 2022** council sessions. *\* Voters will not be able to register for March 2022 at the June 2022 council session.*
- #2 **ALL VOTERS must** be a member of the council and possess a NDC Membership Card (CURRENT 2020-2022). *\* Pentecostal Young People Union voter do not need a membership card if voting for their perspective auxiliary unless running for an office.*
- #3 **ALL VOTERS FOR MCWA, MEN’S MINISTRY, CHRISTIAN EDUCATION, YOUNG PEOPLE UNION, & SINGLES ALLIANCE must** be registered for the March 2022 & June 2022 sessions with their respective auxiliary registration fees. *\* Voters will not be able to register for March 2022 at the June 2022 council session.*

(Evening Schedule) **Tuesday - Friday 6:00pm - 7:30pm**

*\*Voters will be able to vote during these times above for General Body and all Auxiliaries.*

**ALL ELECTION RESULTS WILL BE MADE AVAILABLE BY 6:00PM SATURDAY JUNE 25, 2022**
