

NDC ELECTION *June Annual Session2026*

Guidelines and Procedures

GENERAL BODY VOTING -

#1. ALL Voters MUST be register with the General Body for the MARCH 2026 & JUNE 2026 Council Sessions

* Voters **WILL NOT be able to REGISTER for the MARCH 2026 Council at the JUNE 2026** Council Session.

#2. ALL Voters MUST be a MEMBER of the Council & Possess a NDC MEMBERSHIP CARD (CURRENT YEAR 2024-2026).

* **Voters can not purchase current card at the JUNE 2026 Council Session.**

* Voters MUST have became a MEMBER by OCTOBER Council Session 2025.

AUXILIARIES VOTING -

#1. ALL Voters MUST be registered with the GENERAL BODY for the MARCH 2026 & JUNE 2026 Council Sessions.

* Voters WILL NOT be able to REGISTER for the MARCH 2026 Council at the JUNE 2026 Council Session.

#2. ALL Voters MUST be a MEMBER of the Council and Possess a NDC MEMBERSHIP CARD (CURRENT YEAR: 2024-2026).

* **Voters can not purchase current card at the JUNE 2026 Council Session**

* **Voters MUST have became a MEMBER by the OCTOBER Council Session 2025.**

NOTE: * The PYPV Voters DO NOT need a MEMBERSHIP CARD, ONLY if, Voting for their perspective AUXILIARY. However, if you are RUNNING FOR AN OFFICE, you MUST have a NDC MEMBERSHIP CARD.

#3. ALL VOTERS FOR ANY AUXILIARIES IN THE NDC (as is listed in the NDC MINUTE BOOK) MUST be Registered for the MARCH 2026 & JUNE 2026 Sessions with their Respective AUXILIARY BASED ON THE AUXILIARY REGISTRATION FEES, and in According with the AUXILIARY BYLAWS.

* **Voters WILL NOT be able to REGISTER for The MARCH 2026 Council at the JUNE 2026 Council Session.**

(Daytime Schedule) TUESDAY - FRIDAY 10:00 am - 2:00 pm

(Evening Schedule) TUESDAY - FRIDAY 5:30 pm - 7:00 pm

*SATURDAY 10:00 am - 2:30 pm (ONLY)

** Voters will be able to vote during these DAYS and TIMES for BOTH GENERAL and ALL AUXILIARIES.

** ALL ELECTION RESULTS WILL BE MADE AVAILABLE BY 6:00 PM SATURDAY- JUNE 27, 2026 ON WEBSITE

* The Compliance Department Shall have the Authority to intervene and to make RECOMMENDATIONS on all issues pertaining to ELECTIONS.

*** The Diocesan Bishop (Bishop Ira Combs, Jr) will have the FINAL AUTHORITY to Act as he may determine.
