


AGG Scholarship Announcements

Honorary Scholarship for High School Graduates

• Who Can Apply: Any high school senior who has successfully earned a diploma.

• Eligibility Requirements:

- Complete the official AGG enrollment form
- Present proof of high school graduation (diploma)

- The essay helps our committee understand your background, dedication, and how you align with AGG's mission.
- We value individuals who exhibit strong faith, leadership, and a commitment to making a positive impact.

Selection Process:

- Essays are evaluated based on clarity, authenticity, and alignment with AGG's values.
