This is how I make a faux piped binding that is completely done by machine. The binding is attached to the back of the quilt then folded over to the front where it is securely stitched down between the accent/piping fabric and the binding fabric. I like it because it is fast compared to genuine piping, easy with no tricky corners, and very secure. It also adds real impact to the finished quilt.
