

Angel Gown

There are several YouTube videos out there that demonstrate how to construct an Angel Gown. The YouTube video that I followed or that matches with my directions is "How to Sew Angel Gowns from Upcycled Wedding Dresses"

Please read through all my instructions before sewing.

I have cut out 3 different sizes of gowns. For each you will need a front and a back pattern piece.

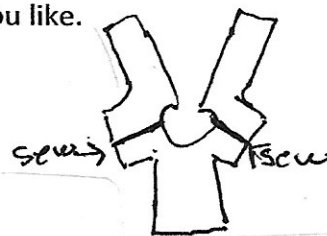
If you are tracing your own pattern pieces from mine please be careful to mark your size and the pattern information on each pattern piece, ie. (place on fold, cut from main, and cut from lining, etc.)

Instructions:

1st cut out your pattern pieces

2nd decorate the front of the gown.

3rd sew the shoulder seams together. Sew the main fabrics to the main fabric and the lining fabric to the lining fabric. You will have 4 sets. Press however you like.



4th Pin gown right sides together. Line up the neck edge and pin. Line up the center backs and pin. Line up the sleeves and pin, at the outside edge.

5th Sew up one back around the neck and down the other back, using a ¼ inch seam allowance.

On one of the back edges leave a 2 inch opening for turning the gown right side out at the end.

6th Sew along the sleeve edge with a ¼ inch seam allowance.

7th Clip the curved neck and the corners where the neck and the back pieces meet. Be careful to not clip through your stitches. Turn your gown right side out and press.
