Portland, OR – March 6, 2026 – The Redwood Project today issued the following statement praising President Donald J. Trump's cybersecurity strategy:

“President Trump's cybersecurity strategy effectively integrates cybersecurity with our broader national security objectives, a move that deserves commendation. It signals a clear shift from a cautious, regulation-heavy approach to a more aggressive, streamlined, and 'hard power' posture. This forward-leaning stance means that bad actors can anticipate more aggressive offensive cyber operations from agencies like the CIA and NSA, greater support and collaboration from the private sector, and a stronger focus on cybercrime investigation and prosecution by the Department of Justice. This shift in posture is designed to fundamentally change adversary calculations.”
