


People Can Be Recycled Too!



What Does Recycle Mean?


A simple definition for the word recycle is to say that something new is made from something old. It is saved from destruction and put to a good use. It is given a brand new purpose!



You Can Be Recycled To A New Life

This recycle process can happen to you too. It's something that God will do for you. You can be saved from destruction (TITUS 3:5), given a new life (ROMANS 6:4) and you can discover a new purpose. (EPHESIANS 2:10)


- › Would you like a new life with a new purpose?

1. Realise that you have 'fallen short' and are separated from God because of your sin


'All have fallen short of the glory of God' (ROMANS 2:23)



God and Man are separated by Sin


2. God's free gift to you is eternal life. It was paid for by his Son, Jesus Christ, when he died on the cross for you

'for the wages of sin is death; but the free gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.' (ROMANS 6:23)



3. Christ died for you, taking your sin penalty upon himself, to bring you to God.

'Jesus died on the cross in your place to pay the penalty for your sin. For Christ also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, that he might bring us to God.' (1 PETER 3:18)



4. You need to repent (change your attitude toward sin). Tell God you are sorry for your sin and turn away from it.

'No, I tell you; but unless you repent, you will all likewise perish.'
(LUKE 13:3)




Say no to sin and yes to righteousness

5. Thank Jesus for dying on the cross for you and ask Him to forgive you of your sins

'But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name he gave the right to become children of God.' (JOHN 1:12)

'In whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.' (COLOSSIANS 1:14)

'If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.' (ROMANS 10:9)



Billy Graham's Prayer for Salvation

The following is the prayer used by Billy Graham in leading millions to Christ throughout the world. You can make it your prayer.

'O God, I am a sinner. I'm sorry for my sins. I'm willing to turn from my sins. I receive Christ as saviour. I confess Him as Lord. From this moment on I want to follow Him and serve Him in the fellowship of His church. In Christ's Name. Amen.'

6. God's word assures you that you now have eternal life in His Son, Jesus Christ

'And this is the testimony, that God gave us eternal life and this life is in his Son. Whoever has the Son has life; whoever does not have the Son of God does not have life. I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God that you may know and have eternal life.' (1 JOHN 5: 11-13)



7. Summary....

1. Realise you are a sinner
2. Christ died for your sin
3. You must turn away from your sin (repent)
4. You must believe (trust) Christ
5. Pray to receive Jesus
6. Be assured of your salvation (1 JOHN 5: 11-13)


