



## **Mid-South Model United Nations (MSMUN) School Insurance Requirement**

Dear Advisor,

First, thank you for your interest in attending MSMUN, the Mid-South's premier Model United Nations Conference! We are beyond excited for what this year has in store, and we hope that you will be able to join us for another year of amazing debate! We cannot wait to see you and hear all the amazing ideas that your students have for their committees!

Now that we have the formalities out of the way, I wanted to pass along some pertinent information regarding the insurance policy required for schools to attend MSMUN. As you may be aware, Rhodes College and the International Studies Department at Rhodes College are gracious enough to allow us to use the College buildings to host the conference, and with that, we are required to comply with the College's Protection of Minors for Outside Organizations requirement. The College's requirements are listed below:

1. Certificate of Insurance documenting \$ 1 million in general liability coverage and \$1 million in sexual assault molestation
2. Certification or documentation that all chaperones employed or engaged by the school (any adult attending in a supervisory role of minors) have successfully completed and passed a criminal background check
3. Certification or documentation that all chaperones employed by the school have successfully completed protection of minors training.

For those schools associated with a school district, your district likely has this information for each school in the district (if your district has one policy covering every school in the district, that works as well).

Unfortunately, given that these requirements are mandatory requirements for all organizations hosting minors on Rhodes' campus, we are required to collect these documents from each delegation.
