Bonnie's insights on spring planting and the effects of the environment on our gardens

I love self-seeders and consider myself my garden's editor more than some grand planner who must have her way. It amazes me how different my garden is than the one I thought I wanted decades ago, and how much more unusual and exciting it is. I let nature guide me. I will talk about the gardener's role in tracking the changes we're seeing in our gardens due to environmental pollutants and climate change—loss of pollinators, rise in infestations of Japanese Beetles, the effect of unpredictable snow cover in winter (often mistaken for extreme cold, when what kills plants is sudden cold at the wrong time without adequate cover for plants), monsoon-like rains and then long dry spells and such. All these things have changed the way we garden, so as a garden writer I help people adapt. Join me and the Mahtomedi Garden Club on February 12 to learn more!
