- 2. Create a plan for your design including at least one pollinator plant. If the base for your arrangement is greater than 12 inches, please let Sue know so she can plan for an appropriate table/pedestal.
- 3. Plan to arrive at the White Bear Center of the Arts at noon on the day of the event so we can have everything in place when the doors open at 1pm. Prepare to relax and enjoy the afternoon. Artists will be invited to share an artist statement revealing insights on their design if you desire, but it is not required.
