## ACTIVITIES

- Distribute Journey Totes during foster care and housing transitions

- Connect families to community-based resources

## OUTPUTS

### ANNUAL METRICS

- 300+ Journey Totes distributed to youth in transition
- 25 to 40 workshops delivered across literacy, financial, and career readiness topics
- 250 to 400 youth and young adults served annually

- 500+ hours of mentoring and coaching provided
- 100+ resource referrals completed with follow-up support

## SHORT-TERM OUTCOMES

(Now to 12 Months)

- 85% report feeling safer and more supported
- 80% increased engagement in learning
- 75% improved emotional regulation and confidence

## INTERMEDIATE OUTCOMES

(1-3 Years)

- 70% improve reading, financial literacy, or life skills
- 65% set and pursue academic/career goals
- 60% improved decision making/problem solving

## LONG-TERM OUTCOMES

(3-5 Years)

- 60% achieve employment/training/postsecondary enrollment
- 55% increased financial independence
- 40% reduction in reliance on crisis services

## IMPACT

(5-10 Years)

- Youth break cycles of instability and foster care re-entry
- Stronger families and healthier communities
- Long-term reduction in generational poverty and trauma

Early, dignity-centered intervention produces measurable outcomes that reduce long-term social service costs and strengthen communities.
