Important Attendee Information:

1. Construction Code Education (CCedu) is a CT Electrical Work Examining Board (EWEB) Approved Provider. Principal Instructor is Brian Mitchell. This course meets the minimum requirements as set forth by the Commissioner.
2. Please preregister by Mail, Email, or Fax. **Registration is on a first-paid first-serve basis.** Class size is limited to fifty- (50) attendees per class. **A confirmation will be sent via e-mail. Please insure that your e-mail address appears legibly on your Registration Form.** Registrants that do not have an e-mail address will receive a confirmation by telephone. Payment must accompany registration otherwise it will be due the day of class "at-the-door".
3. EWEB policy requires each attendee to bring and have in their possession during the Program a 2017 NEC* code book [hard copy or electronic (tablet, notebook, or laptop; no cell phone version)] and a calculator. **YOU MUST HAVE THESE TO BE ADMITTED TO CLASS!** We do not supply these.
4. We do have the Stallcup's 2017 NEC* Major Changes books available for \$99.00 each, tax included which you are not required to purchase. E-mail us to reserve a copy!
5. EWEB policy requires each attendee to have their current electrical license and personal photo-identification at the time of Program sign-in to gain admission to the Program. **Program sign-in will begin one-half hour prior to the start of each session.**
6. The completion Certificate(s) required for your license renewal records will be issued only at the completion of each class.

Cancellation, Transfer, and Refund Policy:

1. Requests received in writing, faxed, or e-mailed two (2) weeks prior to the class date attendee initially registered into have the following options:
 - A. You may take the same Program on a different date provided there is room available on the alternate date; or
 - B. You may request a refund** (if payment had been made in advance/prior to class).

The Electrical Work Examining Board has instructed all Continuing Education Providers, such as *ConstructionCode.Education*, to hold separate Limited License Type classes in the following arrangements.

**The EWEB Will Only Allow CE Providers The Following Arrangements For “2019 Renewal Year
Connecticut Electrical CE Classes” With Low Voltage Type Licensees.**

- I. Any Single License Type Individually.
- II. C-5, C-6, L-5, and L-6 class combination.
- III. C-5, C-6, T-1, and T-2 class combination.
- IV. L-5 and L-6 together in one class.
- V. T-1 and T-2 together in one class.
- VI. C-5 and C-6 together in one class.
- VII. C-7 and C-8 together in one class.
- VIII. PV-1 and PV-2 together in one class.



CONSTRUCTIONCODE.EDUCATION (CCedu) CLASS ARRANGEMENTS

CCedu will maintain the locations, dates, and times as shown on the “CCedu 2019 Renewal Year Class Program Schedule” shown on page 1 of this Flyer. In additional public or private classes can and may be scheduled throughout the EWEB Renewal Year (October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019). 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CONSTRUCTIONCODE.EDUCATION (CCedu) CLASS COSTS

- I. ¹ CCedu group classes (10 attendees or greater) are \$49.⁰⁰ per person.
- II. CCedu group classes (less than 10 attendees) will be \$500.⁰⁰ divided by the number of attendees.
- III. CCedu individual one-on-one class, at our office, is \$500.⁰⁰
