SAMPLE LETTER OF SPONSORSHIP

I have been playing the violin for about eight years and have participated in various orchestras, including the Lighthouse Youth Orchestra, Redlands Youth Symphony, and San Bernardino County Honors Orchestra. As an integral part of the Lighthouse Youth Orchestras, I have been able to attend multiple musical festivals, where my orchestra has won first place in our division as well as many gold ratings. Individually, I have also received an Outstanding Musicianship Award for my musical contribution to my ensemble. In addition to my experience as an orchestra member, I have also had the privilege of participating in a few chamber groups as well as performing repertoire for solo competitions.

I am very excited to announce an amazing opportunity that I have the chance to be part of next summer. The Mountaintop Strings of California, directed by Sharon Rizzo, is planning a three week Italian performance program called "Musical Escapades Through Italy" that will take place from June 19 to July 10, 2022. This program accepts musicians from all over the country, and I have been accepted by audition. We will be rehearsing and performing in Tuscany, Perugia, and Venice. This is a chance for me to grow as a musician and perform and rehearse in some wonderful historic venues, such as Vivaldi's own Church, the Chiesa della Pietá in Venice, and in the iconic hill town of San Gimignano, we will be rehearsing in the 14th century Monastery of Sant'Agostino. We may also have an opportunity to perform in The Pantheon in Rome and other famous basilicas. While we will perform mostly Baroque and Classical music, we will also be putting together a Jazz & Pop program as an invitation has been made to participate in the Umbria Jazz Festival, which takes place in Perugia, Italy. This is one of the most important jazz festivals worldwide and has had many well-known artists perform. While this is a musical program, there are also a number of opportunities to explore and experience the abundance of culture that Italy has to offer.

The tuition for this program costs \$4,999. This price includes accommodations in centrally located areas, concert venues, ground transportation, some meals as well as a few group excursions. In addition, I would also be responsible for my airfare which could be an additional \$1,100 - \$1,500. Participation in a program like this would not be possible without the generosity of people such as yourself, which is why I am reaching out to you.
