Saturday, June 13 Flight Los Angeles to Rome

Sunday, June 14- June 18 Arrive Rome Fiumicino Airport, meet our AMAZING Tour Leader **Francesca D'Angola.** Welcome Dinner at an authentic *Roman Trattoria*. Spend the Next 4 nights in our centrally located hotel in Rome. Take in the incredible ancient Roman sites and the FOUNTAINS of ROME all sparkly for the Jubilee Year (not boarded up – YAAY!) Optional Bike Tour of All the Sites! *Start Concertizing! Get over that Jet Lag!*



Thursday, June 18 – June 25 Hop aboard our air-conditioned motorcoach and head for the Tuscan Countryside where we will spend the next 7 nights in a Tuscan Farmhouse- *Fattoria* or *Agriturismo* as the Italians call it! Here we will have apartments, a pool and a restaurant. Relax & walk among the vineyards. Rehearsals on the farm to brush up on our music and just play for fun. Daytrips and concert possibilities in Vinci, (the home of the worlds greatest genius, artist and inventor, *Leonardo da Vinci*), Pisa, Lucca, Siena. Perhaps an optional Bike Ride through the Tuscan Countryside.



Thursday, June 25- June 29 4 Nights Montecatini (Still part of Tuscany) – a beautiful small Italian Spa Town, lots of shops and cafes. On the train line. Perhaps take a ride on the regional train to Florence. Concerts TBD in this area.



Monday, June 29 – July 2 Head North to the VIOLIN MAKING CAPITAL OF THE WORLD! Spend the next 3 nights in the small village of CREMONA! You will have time to buy that ROSIN you missed out on in 2024 and visit the violin making shops. Maybe you want to buy a new Violin, Viola or Cello ⁽²⁾ We will most likely be a part of the *Cremona Summer Festival again*, a favorite in this music town. Possible day trip to Parma, famous for *Parmigiano Reggiano Cheese* and *Prosciutto di Parma!*



Thursday, July 2 – July 4 We will leave Cremona and head for Venice with a possible lunch stop in Mantua or Padua - remember ROMEO was banned to Mantua for pursuing Juliet! (this depends on when our Venice Concert will be, and what route the driver will take). Spend our final 2 nights in our centrally located hotel in Venice. Cross your fingers we can get our concert at VIVALDI's CHURCH for a third time! MTSC will sponsor a *Gondola Ride* through the Canals for travelers and a Farewell Dinner.

Saturday, July 4 Ciao Italia! Wave goodbye as this Incredible Tour of a Lifetime comes to an end. Sight - Venice to Los Angeles.

Eligibility, Criteria, Rehearsal & Performance Commitment

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Current strings musicians in Big Bear Lighthouse and Arrowhead Arts YAE
- Current strings musicians in Big Bear Lighthouse Chamber Strings (minimum must have completed 7th grade at time of travel)
- College strings musicians/alum who are still involved in music and play at a high level
- Young Professional Strings Musicians
- Piano Accompanist by Audition
- Parent Chaperones and guests by approval
- **Musicians under 14** must have their own chaperone. (If the parent is not going, another parent or adult must agree to be responsible the entire time)

CRITERIA & EXPECTATIONS FOR MUSICIANS:

- Private lessons required with a professional, degreed, teacher on your instrument.
- Mountain string players in middle & high school must be a participant in good standing in either LYO or Arrowhead Arts programs.
- If there are any players from other areas, alternate arrangements will be made.
- Must be committed to learning the music, following all instructions of preparation
- There will be several performance assessments for orchestral players
- Players will be held to high standards and treated like young adults
- Must have a squeaky clean behavior record in all areas of life. The highest level of maturity and responsibility is expected throughout the process and on tour.

Rehearsal & Pre-Tour Concert Expectations:

- 2-3 additional rehearsals/workshops per month outside of your weekly LYO or AAA ensemble, and more as the tour becomes nearer. Includes mostly Sundays, but may also utilize Fridays or Saturdays depending on personnel.
- Rehearsal locations vary depending on availability and where our musicians are from.
- We perform a number of "pre-tour concerts" tour to gain experience and polish music.

Our Music: Tour Music consist of many styles including Baroque, Classical, Sacred, Latin, Jazz, American and light rock, and pieces are assigned at an appropriate level for the different levels of players for a **"multi-level"** ensemble. Music selections are tailored to each of the diverse venues to make wonderful concerts to share with audiences from all over the world.

We encourage qualified parents to join the tour as chaperones to be part of the "team". Chaperones share in the magic and take part in all aspects of the tour, and this is a very rewarding experience. We also welcome approved guests if they are mature enough and physically able to handle the pace of the tour. **We do not recommend that elderly or very young children accompany you on this fast paced tour**. *The pace will be that of active teenagers*.

SOME THINGS TO KNOW FOR ADDITIONAL TRAVELERS (NON- MUSICIANS)

- Parent Chaperones are responsible for the whereabouts and safety of a small group of students. This includes your own child, and you may be asked to look after another whose parent is not present.
- We ask that all members of the tour take part in our activities, and that you support the educational cause of the tour and the hard work of the musicians at all times.
- Be aware that this trip is not a vacation, but a music, cultural and educational experience. BUT WE DO HAVE FUN!
- Parents & Additional Travelers' Tour Fees are the same price as musicians.
- All adult travelers must be able to work well as a team with other adults and be calm, positive and flexible. Must have a good rapport with kids/teenagers.
- Chaperones/Guests stay in the same hotels as musicians, and generally share a room usually with one to two other adults. Singles/Doubles are available for an extra fee. Musicians generally share a room with other musicians.
- We ask that additional travelers help with certain aspects of the tour (luggage, greeters at concerts etc.) and assist with non-musical tasks.
- Chaperones will get some free time 😊
