Show Bill Approved 02.08.2023

- Proper Western/English attire required in all classes
- No Stallions (yearling colts permitted)
- Helmets recommended, not required.
- Pony riders at judge's discretion.

PEE WEE: 10 yrs and under
YOUTH: 11 – 17 yrs
ADULT: 18 yrs – Older
Gate Opens 2 ½ hours before show
Arena Closed 30 minutes before show
Registration Starts 1 ½ hours before show

- All gaited class horses must be trail shod/no pads, clips, or bands.
- Exhibitors under 18 must have parent or responsible party sign for them.
- Class must have a 2 horse minimum to offer year end award

1. OPEN PLEASURE DRIVING

Any Breed, Walk & Road Gaits

2. HALTER - Points awarded to horse

- a. Pony/Mini (must be 54" & Under
- b. Yearlings
- c. Mare 2 yrs & older
- d. Gelding 2 yrs & older
- e. Gaited Horse

3. LEAD LINE

Riders 7 yrs & under. Must be led by an adult, cannot ride in any other pleasure class. Points awarded to rider.

4. OPEN ENGLISH PLEASURE

Horse or pony. Open to any age.

5. PEE WEE WALK TROT

Horse & pony. Points to horse rider. Rider cannot show in 8 or 11.

6. OPEN MULE

Walk, Trot & Favorite Gait

7. OPEN HORSEMANSHIP W/T

Points to horse/rider pair. English, Western, Gaited. Rider cannot show in 4, 8, 14, 11 or 16.

8. OPEN HORSEMANSHIP W/T/C

Points awarded to horse/rider pair. English, Western, Gaited.

9. ADULT WALK TROT

Points awarded to horse/rider pair. English or Western. Rider cannot show in 4, 8, 11, or 16.

10. COUNTRY PLEASURE

Points awarded to horse/rider pair. English or Western. Gaited horse or pony. Pleasure gait & Extended gait.

11. RANCH PLEASURE

Points awarded to horse/rider pair. Horse or pony. Western ranch attire.

12. YOUTH GAITED

Points awarded to horse/rider pair. Gaited horse or pony. Western or English. Trail walk and pleasure gait. Trail shod.

13. YOUTH WALK TROT

Points awarded to horse/rider pair. English or Western. Rider cannot show in 4, 8, 11, or 16.

14. ADULT WESTERN PLEASURE

Points awarded to horse/rider pair.

15. ALL DAY GAITED PLEASURE

Points awarded to horse/rider pair. Western or English. Trail walk and pleasure gait. Trail shod.

16. YOUTH WESTERN PLEASURE

Points awarded to horse/rider pair.

St. Clair Saddle Club Rules and Regulations

- 1. The use of alcohol, controlled substances or profanity will not be permitted on club grounds.
- 2. Abuse of any animals will not be allowed on club grounds at any time.
- 3. Judge's decision is final in all classes.
- 4. A horse is an animal over 54 inches tall, a pony is 54 inches and under. Mules under 54" may be shown as ponies.
- 5. The determining age of a rider will be their age as of January 1.
- 6. Exhibitors must show in over 50% of any class to be eligible for year-end awards.
- 7. An exhibitor or their representative acting on behalf of an exhibitor, guilty of unsportsmanlike conduct, or challenging a judge, ring master, show official or member of show committee, in an abusive or obscene manner will not be tolerated; exhibitor will be disqualified from the show and asked to leave the club grounds. This also applies to all club activities.
- 8. All non-equine animals will be kept on a lead
- 9. Any equine can be entered only one time per class, no exception. Additional riders on same equine will be considered exhibition only.
- 10. All equines must be under control when entering and leaving the arena.
- 11. There will be no re-ride after a disqualification, including equipment breakdown.
- 12. Pole bending: each pole knocked down will be a 2 second penalty.
- 13. Barrel racing: a barrel knocked down is a 5 second penalty.
- 14. Flag race: any knocked down marker or missed flag is a disqualification.
- 15. Whipping will be allowed in the arena only in a humane manner, with a humane whipping device. Whipping in front of the girth is not allowed.
- 16. Off course on any pattern is a disqualification.
- 17. Long pants and long-sleeved shirts required for all classes. Shorts and tank tops are not allowed in the arena on show day.
- 18. Equine will be run in the order they are signed up in. Running out of order will be a disqualification. 2 minutes/3 calls will be given to enter the arena after you are called.
