The new Covid-19 rules allow:

- Worship to continue up to the risk-assessed numbers agreed for the space in church. (So we can carry on as we have been for now)
- Business meetings to carry on the work of the church to be held.
 Funerals to have upto 30 people present
- Weddings to have up to 15 people present
- Baptisms *outside* normal worship only 6 people (plus vicar & verger) but if part of Sunday worship the family are included in the risk assessed numbers for worship.

We have been advised that we have to have our annual parish meeting by the end of October (charity law apparently!). We therefore give notice that the APCM of North Wearside Parish is to be held at

10am on Sunday 25th October at St Cuthbert's Church.

important stuff we need to do:

1. Nominate 4 Church wardens (parish wardens in our case)
Each needs to be nominated by a proposer and a seconder both of
whom must live in North Wearside Parish or be on the electoral roll.

2. Nominate PCC members

We are allowed up to 9 members. They must be on the electoral roll and, if not already done, do the online safeguarding training required by the Diocese.

3. Nominate 2 Deanery Synod representatives

They must be on the electoral roll, do the online safeguarding training and be prepared to report to the PCC on the deanery and national issues raised at deanery meetings. (They are also eligible to be elected to the Diocesan Bishop's Council and General Synod)

4. Revise the electoral roll.

To make sure it's up to date and add anyone who would like to be able to vote at APCMs and nominate PCC members and Deanery reps or be on the PCC!

We currently have 72 people on the electoral roll but sadly we have had a number of deaths and departures. Please check the list if you can which will be published on a notice board in church and on the website and alert Jen of any amendments required. You will stay on the roll if you are already on it. If you would like to be on the roll please fill in a form. All forms will be available from our parish website or from Jen.

We will aim to publish the APCM (probably via the parish facebook page) on a live stream - rather like the "coffee and chat" that Chantal and Tony used to have. Watch this space!
