

Bursary Application Process

St. Joseph's Parish has instituted a bursary program in order to support parishioners who desire a Catholic education for their children, but who find it difficult to manage the cost of tuition. In order to ensure an equitable distribution of funds, families who would like assistance must make formal application. The committee will consider all applications and provide support accordingly.

Please note that the parish is offering support only to parishioners who are applying to St. Joseph's School for the first time, and only for tuition. Each family is responsible to cover all registration fees, supplies and any parent participation fees.

Applications for financial assistance will be submitted in confidence to the Bursary Committee for consideration. Please be assured that all applications will remain confidential and will only be seen by members of this committee.

Applications must be submitted every year for consideration. The availability of funds will dictate the amount of assistance that can be provided. The goal of the Bursary Committee is to support as many families as possible, and so the amount of assistance will not equal the full tuition fees. It is expected that families will contribute to the tuition fees as well.

In order to apply for the bursary, families must complete the attached forms and submit them to the parish office. Please note that the forms will be destroyed at the end of every school year, in order to maintain confidentiality and privacy.

We look forward to supporting our parish families in their quest to raise their children in the Catholic faith, by welcoming them to St. Joseph's School.
