We hope you and your family can join us on that day. The Parish is also holding a Lunar New Year Celebration that day, details are attached.


Colour Day | Wednesday, February 12th

Re-registration packages and Kindergarten Registration

Re-registration packages will be sent home on February 18th, and MUST be returned by Friday, February 28th. Please note that each registration for kindergarten to grade 4 will be charged \$50 for school supplies at the time of registration. Grade 5-7 will be given a list of supplies needed.

We ask that you drop off your forms to Mrs. Laxamana and Mrs. Symington between the hours of 8am to 5pm. This will allow us to check your forms and take your payment immediately and finish the process quickly. Forms received after February 28th will be charged a \$50 late fee.

Re-registration forms MUST be submitted by a parent ONLY.

Students MAY NOT submit forms/payment. Forms will be sent back home with them.

Income tax forms will be sent home with your child's re-registration package.

Our school system has been able to issue Income Tax receipts for the religious portion of tuition paid since 1998. This income tax receipt is to be claimed as a charitable donation on your income tax return. To do so, please enter the amount of the tax receipt on line 34900 (Charitable Donations) of your income tax return.

Participation and Fundraising Goals

Statements will be coming home next week to show your participation and fundraising totals so far. Please note that the statements will be up to date as of January 31. You will have until the end of May 2025 to complete the hours and fundraising, at which time a bill will be sent for immediate payment if there is a balance owing.
