



Summer Camp Sessions 2026

Session 1 — The Great Outdoors

Campers spend the week exploring nature, caring for farm animals, playing outdoor games, and creating crafts inspired by life on the farm. This intro week is perfect for new and returning campers who love being outside, learning about animals, and enjoying classic summer fun!

Session 2 — Gardening & Pumpkin Planting

Campers learn how pumpkins grow from seed to harvest and get hands-on experience planting their own pumpkin seeds. We'll explore the garden, talk about soil and pollinators, and each camper takes home a planted pumpkin starter. Campers are also invited back in the fall during our Pumpkin Carving event to pick one pumpkin for free if they choose!

Session 3 — Farm Animals & Veterinary Care

Perfect for animal lovers! Campers learn about daily animal care, feeding, grooming, health checks, and how veterinarians keep farm animals healthy. Hands-on activities help kids understand anatomy, wellness exams, basic nutrition, and more. A great peek into the world of real farm animal care!

Session 4 — Patriotic Week

Red, white, and blue fun all week long! Campers make red-white-and-blue tie-dye T-shirts, create patriotic crafts, play outdoor games, enjoy farm activities, and celebrate summertime. We wrap up the week on Friday with a red-white-and-blue ice cream social and awards ceremony to kick off the holiday weekend!



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Session 5 — Life on a Working Farm

This immersive week teaches campers what it's really like to live and work on a farm. Activities include gardening, collecting eggs, feeding animals, and tackling kid-friendly chores. We'll also create using natural resources from the farm—felted with alpaca fiber, pouring beeswax candles, and building small projects using farm materials. It's hands-on, creative, and unforgettable!

Session 6 — Farm Food Week: Garden to Table

From soil to supper! Campers explore where food comes from as they harvest garden ingredients, collect eggs, pick herbs, and prepare simple recipes. We'll learn about healthy food choices, seasonal produce, and sustainability—and even make fresh cheese or ice cream using fresh milk. A delicious and educational farm-to-table adventure!

Session 7 — Building, Creativity & Farm Engineering

This week focuses on problem-solving, design, and building! Campers learn how farms use tools, structures, and simple machines to get work done. Through hands-on building projects, tool safety, and creative engineering challenges, campers construct small projects using farm materials and learn to think like innovators and makers.

Session 8 — Mad Scientists Week: Farm Experiments

Mix, fizz, bubble, and explore! Campers become junior scientists as they investigate the science happening all around the farm. We'll experiment with soil, plants, pollination, microbes, weather, chemistry, and more through messy, exciting, hands-on projects. Curiosity and discovery take the lead this week!



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Session 9 — Farm Animal Olympics

Let the games begin! This lively week features team-based challenges, relays, obstacle courses, and hilarious farm-themed events like egg-and-spoon races and hay bale tosses. We focus on teamwork, sportsmanship, and confidence-building—ending with a medal ceremony and lots of smiles!

Session 10 — Survivor Week: Farm Challenge

Outwit, Outplay, Outfarm! Campers join teams and tackle outdoor survival-style challenges including shelter building, scavenger hunts, knot tying, obstacle courses, and problem-solving missions. Teams earn points all week for effort, teamwork, and completing challenges—ending in our Farm Challenge Finale!

Session 11 — Celebration Week: Farm Luau

Our summer season ends with a celebration for new and returning campers! This week features a “greatest hits” mix of favorite activities—water play, games, crafts, animal time, and more. On Friday we host our festive Farm Luau with music, leis, treats, and fun awards for every camper. A perfect final week of summer!
