At the heart of these discussions was the ASEAN Digital Economy Framework Agreement, which presents transformative possibilities for the region.

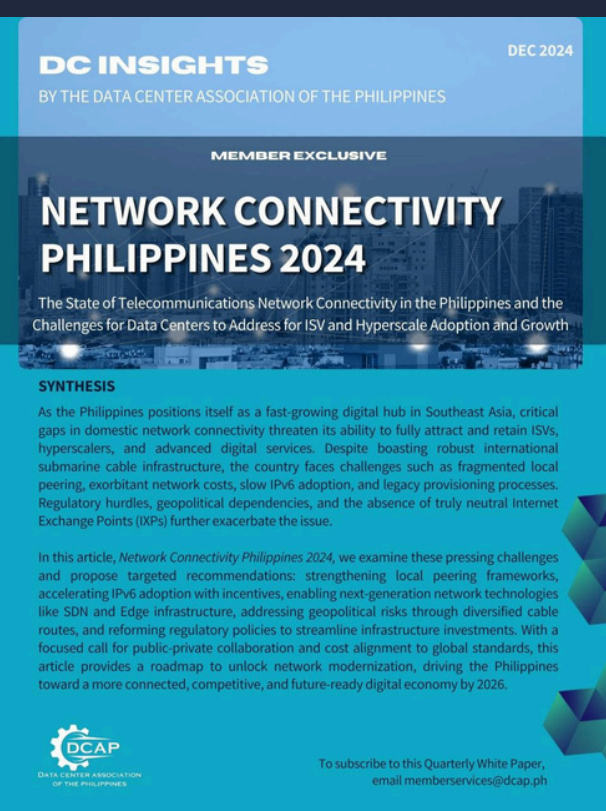
The esteemed panel included Steven Davis, Chairman and Co-Founder of the DCAP and Patrick Signo, Co-Founder and Board Member of DCAP.

DCI DATA CENTERS LAUNCHES \$70 MILLION HIGH-SECURITY DATA CENTRE TODAY IN SOUTH AUSTRALIA

DCI Data Centers (DCI) has recently officially launched its second data centre in South Australia. The A\$70 million secure facility is the first of its kind and ready to support the growing IT infrastructure needs for the state. Named Adelaide 02 (ADL02), the 4 MW site is a purpose-built TIER-Ready III, secure cloud edge data centre that can accommodate large IT capacity and programs of work with the ability to address higher security requirements should they be needed.
