5. Please include a picture of you and your horse.

## Selection Timeline

1. Completed application and required materials must be received by Brindle Ridge Farms on or before Monday, May 30, 2022 via email.

3. Explain what discipline you ride, what competitions you have competed in and how the preparation and process of showing has helped you bond with your horse.
4. Which of the following words best describe your contribution to the horse community, please provide a reasoning behind each: **Kind, Committed, Selfless, Respectful, Honest, Patient, Humble, Forgiving.**
