- My favorite experience was driving the Nissan Ariya or talking to the University of Toronto students and professor

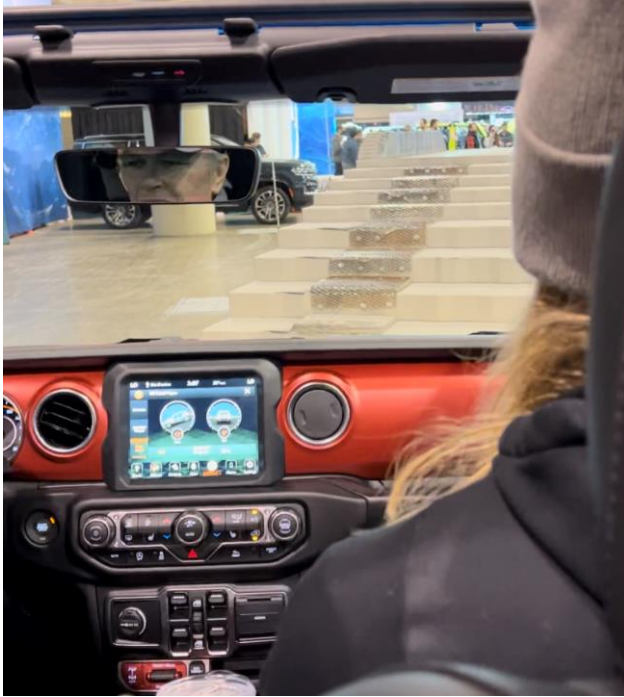




Hzyll's Thoughts
