

MTMI Uniform Policy 2024/2025

Please Note: Uniform is worn everyday, no other clothing underneath or over MTMI uniform will be allowed except the official MTMI uniform. The turnaround time for uniforms are a minimum of three working weeks from receipt of payment. This is subject to our suppliers work load as all uniforms are made to order.

NB: Your child is expected to come to school in a clean uniform every day, to ensure personal hygiene and that the MTMI uniform standard is well maintained.

NB: Please note if your child's hygiene/uniform is not up to standard, MTMI reserves the right to deny any child entry onto the premises, until your child's personal hygiene/uniform is up to MTMI standard. There will be no refunds or exchanges once uniform orders have been placed with the supplier.

Boys Summer Uniform:

- MTMI White, short sleeve open neck shirt.
- MTMI long navy blue school socks with black school shoes.
- If required, blue school jersey or school blazer may be worn.
- A school tie should always be worn with the school blazer.
- If required, long grey trousers may be worn.
- PT short sleeve golf shirts, shorts, white ankle socks and black running shoes/tekkies may be worn every
 Friday and on Sports days.

Boys Winter Uniform:

- MTMI White long sleeve shirt with school tie.
- Long grey trousers with a black belt.
- MTMI long navy blue school socks with black toughees shoes
- If required, navy blue school jersey, pullover, drimac or school blazer may be worn.
- A school tie should always be worn with the school blazer.
- If required, the official school beanie and scarf may be worn.
- PT tracksuits, MTMI navy blue socks and black running shoes/tekkies may be worn every Friday and on Sports days.

Girls Summer Uniform:

- MTMI checked school dress.
- White ankle socks with black toughees shoes.
- If required, navy blue school jersey, pullover or school blazer may be worn.
- PT short sleeve golf shirts, shorts, white ankle socks and black running shoes/tekkies may be worn every **Friday** and on **Sports days**.



Girls Winter Uniform:

- MTMI checked dress.
- Long navy-blue stockings with black toughees shoes.
- If required, navy blue school jersey, pullover, drimac or school blazer may be worn.
- If required, the official school beanie and scarf may be worn.
- PT tracksuits, MTMI navy blue socks and black running shoes/tekkies may be worn every Friday and on Sports days.

P.T Uniform:

- (1 years old Grade R ONLY) PT tracksuits, Drimac suits, golf t-shirts and shorts may be as school uniform
- PT golf t-shirt and short may only be worn with ankle white socks and black running shoes/tekkies.
- PT tracksuits/Drimac suits may only be worn with MTMI navy blue socks and black running shoes/tekkies.
- Learners must bring their PT uniform to school on the days they have PT lessons.
- On the days they do sport during the extra-mural activities and Every Friday (optional).

Grils and Boys Summer PT Uniform:

- MTMI golf T-shirt and shorts.
- White ankle socks and black running shoes/tekkies.
- MTMI navy blue hat.

Girls and Boys Winter PT Tracksuit:

- MTMI PT tracksuits and long sleeve t-shirt.
- MTMI long navy blue long socks and black running shoes/tekkies.
- MTMI navy blue beanie and scarf.

Girls and Boys Winter Drimac suit:

- MTMI Drimac suit and long sleeve t-shirt.
- MTMI long navy blue long socks and black running shoes/tekkies.
- MTMI navy blue beanie and scarf.

Boys:

- Braids are NOT permitted.
- Extensions, including 'Rastafarian' type extensions, are not permitted.
- Hair should be short and natural.
- No Mohawks or other elaborate hairstyles are permitted.
- Earrings are not permitted at all, including on Civvies days or other informal school functions.



Girls:

- Braids are permitted. Braided extensions are permitted provided they are the same color as the natural hair color. 'Rastafarian' type extensions are not permitted.
- Shoulder length hair must be tied back with either MTMI 'scrunchy' or with MTMI ribbons
- ONLY MTMI hair accessories may be worn.
- Earrings are permitted provided that there is only one per ear lobe and that it is either a plain stud or a small, thin sleeper.

General

Hair:

- Hair must always be clean and neat and in a style that is appropriate for school, preferably in its natural state.
- Hair must not hang in the eyes.
- Gels and lotions may only be used for control, not for styling and should not be visible.
- Hair may not be colored, tinted or dyed.

Make-up:

- Make-up may not be worn.
- No lip gloss is allowed.

Jewelry:

- Watches and medical bracelets are allowed.
- No chains or other bracelets are allowed.
- Any other item of jewelry is not allowed.

Nails:

- Nails are to be kept short and clean.
- Nail polish may not be worn.



NO-NO'S!!!

- Grade 1 3 wearing PT uniform worn as school uniform
- The wearing of gloves and beanies in class during lessons.
- Towels wrapped around bodies for warmth.
- Jackets and jerseys wrapped around bodies during the day (throughout the year).
- Long sleeve vest protruding from short sleeve shirts.
- Any colored T-shirts, polo neck or other garments worn under school shirt should not be seen.
- Colored lanyards around necks to be either in pocket or school bag.
- No school shoes without socks.
- Not to wear long navy blue socks/any other color socks with PT shorts and golf shirts ONLY white anckle socks are allowed.
- Combs or any protrusions from hair will not be permitted.
