- Approval of minutes 10/11/2022 - Council Meeting Minutes were approved by unanimous vote after a motion by Karen Phillips and second by Charlene Louk.

Treasurer's Report- Governor Justice will be in town tomorrow @ 2pm to discuss Amendment 2 @ the Senior Center located in downtown Clarksburg. A Task Order was approved today at the Sanitary Bd meeting in the amount of \$278,254.94.

1. Review-Discuss-Consider - Ordinance 2022-10 - An Ordinance of the Town of Nutter Fort, West Virginia, Amending the Schedule of Rates and Charges for the Services and Facilities furnished for the Customers of the Sewerage System of the Town of Nutter Fort by increasing the Rates and Charges by the Establishment of New Rates and Charges. This is a pass-through for a new 18.35% sewage rate increase over 2 ½ years from Clarksburg. If passed on both readings, Step 1 increase will be on the Feb. '23 bill, for January usage. See attached for complete rate percentages and scheduled dates. Approved by unanimous vote after a motion by Charlene Louk and second by Karen Phillips.

2. Review-Discuss-Consider - Christian Heritage Week 2022 Proclamation- were approved by unanimous vote after a motion by Karen Phillips and second by Charlene Louk.

3. Discussion on Personnel Matter- Jeremy initiated an open discussion on the matter about the hiring of 8 to staff the Ambulance. Nathan Rohrbough explained the rationale for hiring of 8 full time employees. Billing process and reimbursement was also discussed. The hiring was approved by unanimous vote after a motion by Rezin Hudkins and a second by Charlene Louk.
