

**Council Meeting
Nutter Fort
May 12, 2015**

The regular council meeting of Nutter Fort, was held, Tuesday, May 12, 2015, in council chambers, with the following members present: William Benincosa, Stephen Korn, Nathan Rohrbough, Karen Phillips, Bruce Kidd, Mayor Nathan Rohrbough, and Recorder Sam Maxon. Councilor Donald Webster was absent. Attending, also, were: Maintenance Supervisor Jim Wolfe, Fire Chief Jeremy Haddix, Treasurer Julia Foley, and Police Chief Ron Godwin. Guests present were Linda Blake, Jim Link, Charlotte Link, Charlene Louk, David Garvin, Jamie Trupo, David Garvin, and Natalie Haddix.

The meeting was called to order at 7:30PM by Mayor Rohrbough, with Councilor Benincosa asking prayer, followed by the pledge of allegiance.

- Karen Phillips motioned to give Chief Godwin authority to sell, at public auction, the 2001 Jeep Cherokee cruiser. After a second by Bruce Kidd, the motion was passed by unanimous vote and a starting bid of \$2500 set. The auction will be Saturday June 13, 2015, with the vehicle being both advertised in the local newspaper and parked out front with a spec sheet for further advertising.

Councilor Donald Webster had mentioned that he heard someone has the intention of building self-storage buildings on Buckhannon Pike. He was unable to attend, due to illness, so the matter was tabled until next meeting.

- Karen Phillips motioned approval of the bills (attached) and, after a second by Stephen Korn, they were approved by unanimous vote.
- The building permits (attached) were approved by unanimous vote following a motion by Karen Phillips and a second by Bruce Kidd.
- The minutes of the April 28, 2015 minutes were approved by unanimous vote after a motion by Bruce Kidd and a second by Karen Phillips.

Old Business There was nothing further to report on the request for a garden spot on Michigan Ave (see April 28, 2015 minutes). Also paperwork providing placing the city as rider on their insurance policy by Trinity Financial in regard to their request of usage for city owned 1405 Buckhannon Pike (see minutes from April 28, 2015), has not been submitted to the office.

- A new business license was granted to Christine's Hot Spot #8, by unanimous vote after a motion by Stephen Korn and a second by William Benincosa.

The complainant did not attend tonight's meeting.
