Town of Nutter Fort Ordinance 2022-06

AN ORDINANCE CREATING, ESTABLISHING AND PROVIDING AN INCREASE FOR THE TOWN OF NUTTER FORT WASTE COLLECTION DEPARTMENT AMENDING AND RE-ENACTING SECTION 6, CHAPTER 5, ARTICLE 951 OF THE NUTTER FORT CODIFIED ORDINANCES

Whereas, the Town of Nutter Fort provides refuse collection services to its residents in the Town of Nutter Fort and close vicinity; and

Whereas, the Town of Nutter Fort deems the present customer rates and charges for the furnishing of refuse collection services throughout the entire territory serviced by the Town of Nutter Fort to be inadequate to provide sufficient revenue to the Town of Nutter Fort to maintain and operate the refuse collection service; and

Whereas, the Town of Nutter Fort deems that a 54% increase in rates and charges is necessary to provide sufficient revenues to the Town of Nutter Fort to maintain and operate the refuse collection service; and

Whereas, in order to provide relief to its residents, the Town of Nutter Fort will implement the increase in residential rates by 54% in four (4) phases; and

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF NUTTER FORT HEREBY ORDAINS: The following amendments to Article 951.06 of the Town's Refuse Collection Code are hereby set forth;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF NUTTER FORT, THAT:

951.06 RATES.

PHASE I – Rates effective May 1, 2022 through April 30, 2023

- (a) <u>Residential.</u> For refuse placed at ground level and not more than fifteen (15) feet from the side of the street or alley from a single-family unit shall be \$18.37 per month.
 - Disabled service. If there has been a special written and verified application to the Mayor, or his/her designee, stating that all persons residing at the residence of the applicant are, by reason of age, infirmity, or other just causes, incapable of complying with the provisions of §951.06(a), dealing with the placement of refuse, then the Mayor, or his/her designee, may waive the provisions dealing with their placement and allow the refuse to be removed from a location which is convenient for the applicant and reasonably convenient for the refuse collector.

PHASE II - Rates effective May 1, 2023 through April 30, 2024

- (a) <u>Residential.</u> For refuse placed at ground level and not more than fifteen (15) feet from the side of the street or alley from a single-family unit shall be \$20.04 per month.
 - Disabled service. If there has been a special written and verified application to the Mayor, or his/her designee, stating that all persons residing at the residence of the applicant are, by reason of age, infirmity, or other just causes, incapable of complying with the provisions of §951.06(a), dealing with the placement of refuse, then the Mayor, or his/her designee, may waive the provisions dealing with their placement and allow the refuse to be removed from a location which is convenient for the applicant and reasonably convenient for the refuse collector.

PHASE III - Rates effective May 1, 2024 through April 30, 2025

- (a) Residential. For refuse placed at ground level and not more than fifteen (15) feet from the side of the street or alley from a single-family unit shall be \$21.71per month.
 - Disabled service. If there has been a special written and verified application to the Mayor, or his/her designee, stating that all persons residing at the residence of the applicant are, by reason of age, infirmity, or other just causes, incapable of complying with the provisions of §951.06(a), dealing with the placement of refuse, then the Mayor, or his/her designee, may waive the provisions dealing with their placement and allow the refuse to be removed from a location which is convenient for the applicant and reasonably convenient for the refuse collector.

PHASE IV – Rates effective May 1, 2025

- (a) <u>Residential.</u> For refuse placed at ground level and not more than fifteen (15) feet from the side of the street or alley from a single-family unit shall be \$23.38 per month.
 - Disabled service. If there has been a special written and verified application to the Mayor, or his/her designee, stating that all persons residing at the residence of the applicant are, by reason of age, infirmity, or other just causes, incapable of complying with the provisions of §951.06(a), dealing with the placement of refuse, then the Mayor, or his/her designee, may waive the provisions dealing with their placement and allow the refuse to be removed from a location which is convenient for the applicant and reasonably convenient for the refuse collector.
