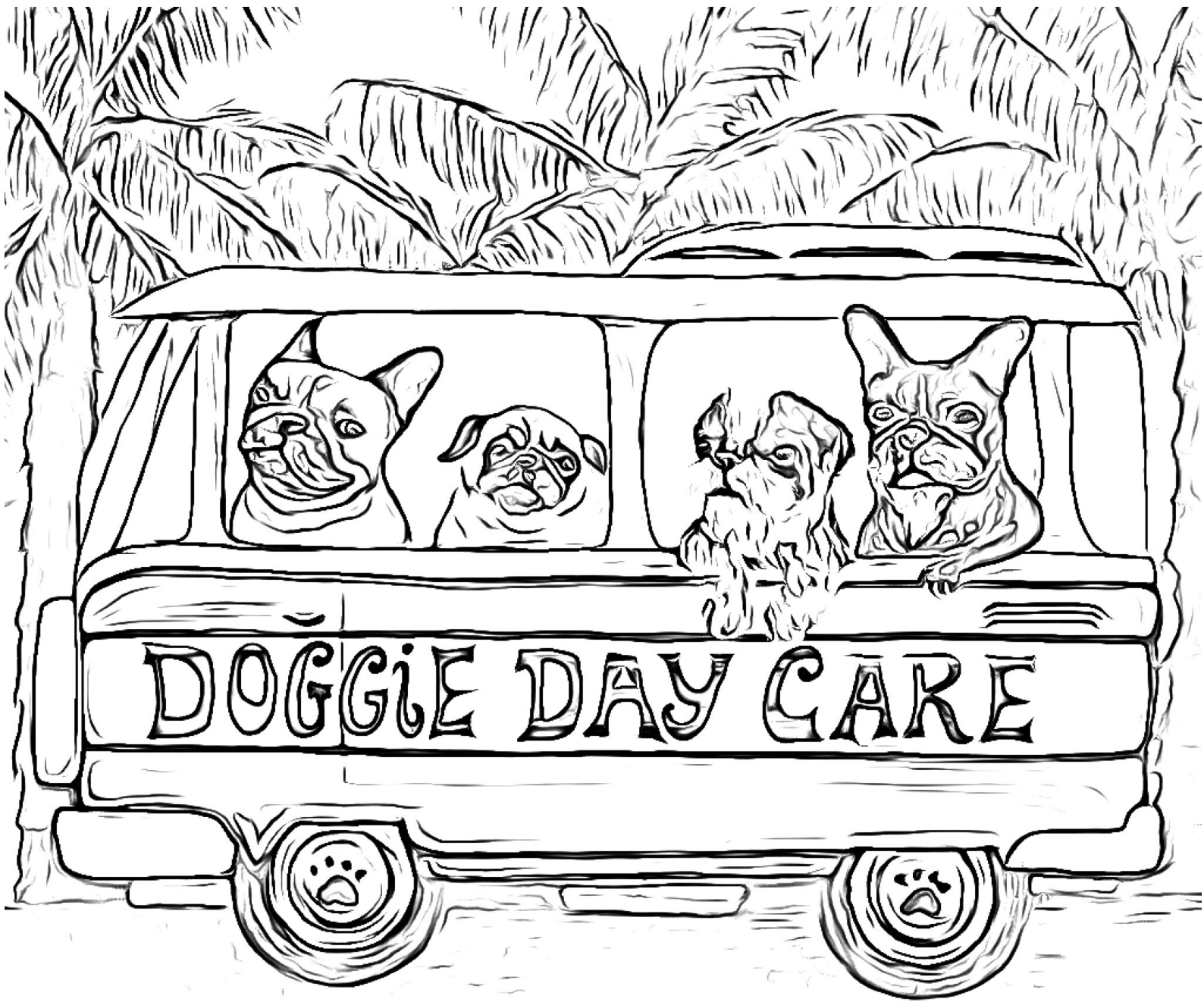




“ON THE DAY OF THE RALLY, FROM A BOX FULL OF SUDS,
