

Ready, Set, GO!

- <u>All-Hazards</u> program to educate and prepare residents for emergencies, incidents, or disasters.
- Approved by all 15 Arizona County Sheriffs
- Common language used statewide

READY

Prepare now.

This means: be aware of the hazards that can threaten your community.

Register with your county/tribal emergency notification system.

Follow your county sheriff's office on social media.

Build an emergency go kit & make a family communication plan.

Stay updated on news and weather.





Be alert.

This means: know there is significant danger in your area.

Consider voluntarily relocating to a shelter or family/friend's home.

Grab your emergency go kit.

Stay updated on news and information from public safety and public health officials.





Evacuate.

This means: danger in your area is imminent and life threatening.

Evacuate immediately to a shelter or family/friend's home.

If you choose to ignore this advisement, you must understand emergency services may not be able to assist you further.

Follow instructions from emergency personnel, stay on designated evacuation routes and avoid closed areas.

Get Ready - Be fire-adapted and ready

Take personal responsibility and prepare long before the threat of a wildland fire, so your home is ready in case of a fire.

Be Set - Be Aware


Pack your emergency items. Know how to receive and stay aware of the latest news and information on the fire from local media, your local fire department and public safety.

Evacuate - Go! - Act early



Follow your personal wildland fire action plan. Also be sure to adhere to your local jurisdiction's evacuation processes.
