GUEST SPEAKERS

Debbie Roznovak from the USFS Black Ranger Mesa District, will make a presentation about their "Travel Management Rule". In order to be compliant with the Travel Management Rule (TMR), the Apache-Sitgreaves National Forests (ASNFs) has to develop a travel plan that designates the roads, trails and open areas where motorized travel is allowed. The plan must consider environmental impacts on watersheds, wildlife habitat, cultural resources and communities.
