

NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE DETAILED FORECAST FOR UPCOMING WEEK

Tonight: Partly cloudy, with a low around 24. Southwest wind 16 to 20 mph, with gusts as high as 31 mph.

Monday: A 20 percent chance of snow showers. Partly sunny, with a high near 35. Breezy, with a southwest wind 16 to 23 mph, with gusts as high as 36 mph.

Monday Night: Snow showers. Patchy blowing snow after midnight. Low around 23. Breezy, with a southwest wind 21 to 25 mph, with gusts as high as 40 mph. Chance of precipitation is 80%. New snow accumulation of 2 to 4 inches possible.

Tuesday: Snow showers. Patchy blowing snow. High near 29. Southwest wind 14 to 17

mph, with gusts as high as 33 mph. Chance of precipitation is 90%. New snow accumulation of 3 to 5 inches possible.

Tuesday Night: Snow showers. The snow could be heavy at times. Patchy blowing snow before 8pm, then patchy blowing snow after 10pm. Low around 22. Southwest wind 10 to 13 mph, with gusts as high as 29 mph. Chance of precipitation is 90%. New snow accumulation of 3 to 7 inches possible.

Wednesday: Snow showers. High near 29. Southwest wind 9 to 13 mph, with gusts as high as 28 mph. Chance of precipitation is 80%. New snow accumulation of less than one inch possible.

Wednesday Night: Snow showers likely. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 22. Southwest wind around 9 mph, with gusts as high as 20 mph. Chance of precipitation is 70%. New snow accumulation of 1 to 2 inches possible.

Thursday: Snow showers likely. Mostly cloudy, with a high near 33. Southwest wind 8 to 11 mph, with gusts as high as 20 mph. Chance of precipitation is 70%.

Thursday Night: Snow showers likely. The snow could be heavy at times. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 24. Southwest wind 7 to 9 mph, with gusts as high as 16 mph. Chance of precipitation is 70%.

Friday: Snow showers. The snow could be heavy at times. Patchy blowing snow between 2pm and 4pm. High near 34. Southwest wind 8 to 11 mph, with gusts as high as 24 mph. Chance of precipitation is 80%.

Friday Night: Snow showers likely. The snow could be heavy at times. Patchy blowing snow. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 20. Southwest wind around 11 mph, with gusts as high as 28 mph. Chance of precipitation is 70%.


New Year's Day: A 50 percent chance of snow showers. Patchy blowing snow. Partly sunny, with a high near 31. Southwest wind 8 to 11 mph, with gusts as high as 28 mph. **Saturday Night**: A 20 percent chance of snow showers. Mostly clear, with a low around 8. Northwest wind 3 to 6 mph. Winds could gust as high as 15 mph.

Sunday: Sunny, with a high near 34. Light and variable wind becoming south around 5 mph.

Deepest Sympathies to the Robert Hunter Family

Robert (Bob) Hunter was born In Trenton, MO on April 15, 1944 and went home to Jesus on December 8, 2021.

He moved with his family to Arizona in the mid 1950s. He married Bonnie George on August 12,1964 and was father to Jeff and Jenny. He was preceded in death by his son Jimmy on November 28,1974. He is survived by granddaughter Becca, grandsons Jimmy, Jacob, Nate Jr., Ben and Jack along with great grandchildren James and Ellie Grace. He is also survived by his sister Alice.

He became an iron worker in the early 1960s and worked at George's Steel. He started B&B Steel Erectors in the 1980s. This business expanded under his honest leadership until 1997 when Bob and his wife resettled in Forest Lakes, AZ where he established Hunter's Crane service.

Bob was ordained as a Deacon at North Phoenix Baptist Church in May 1995 and served in the pre-school ministry where children lovingly referred to him as teacher Bob. In ministry to these children, Bob's heart was healed from the loss of his own son and he was waiting for the call from Jesus and Jimmy to come on home.

Robert was laid to rest in Resthaven Park Cemetery, 6450 W. Northern Avenue, Glendale, Arizona on Wednesday, December 22nd.
