## Coconino County's Winter Parking Ordinance In Effect

### From our County's Sheriff's Deputy McKeever:

An area of concern is people parking in the roadways again. I'm finding that many people who are parking in the roadways are rental houses. I'm asking homeowners who rent their homes out, to relay to their renters there is absolutely NO PARKING in the right of ways or roadways during the winter

months, (see picture of sign that is at all entrances into Forest Lakes).

It is a Coconino County Ordinance. I've always tried to be lenient but times have changed and it's getting to be a problem for plows, so the days of warnings are over. Citations will be issued and vehicles can be towed if necessary.

# CANYON DRIVE IS CLOSED DOWN FOR PUBLIC USE AS OF TODAY AT 8 AM

The only vehicles allowed will be homeowners and Emergency vehicles. This is being done for Public Safety reasons. Once this closure is put in place violators can

be cited. This is the same as the "stupid motorist" law. Our Sheriff's deputy, Robert McKeever, is asking for everyone's cooperation.

**Editor's Note**: Canyon Drive is the road off of Summer Loop that goes to the Pond. It is not maintained by our snow plow because it is on forest lands. All of that property is Forest Service land. Please do not go there for sledding or playing near the pond. To repeat, this is for everyone's safety. Also note that year around, there are No Parking signs along the road, only in the small parking lot. You vehicle is subject to being towed away.

### NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE UPDATED FORECAST FOR TODAY THROUGH MONDAY

**Today**: Snow showers likely, mainly after 11am. Cloudy, with a high near 33. Southwest wind 13 to 20 mph, with gusts as high as 31 mph. Chance of precipitation is 60%. Total daytime snow accumulation of around an inch possible.

**Tonight**: Snow showers. Low around 28. Southwest wind 13 to 16 mph, with gusts as high as 25 mph. Chance of precipitation is 80%. New snow accumulation of 1 to 2 inches possible.

**Friday**: Snow showers. Patchy blowing snow between 11am and 4pm. High near 35. Southwest wind 10 to 18 mph, with gusts as high as 29 mph. Chance of precipitation is 100%. New snow accumulation of 3 to 5 inches possible.

**Friday Night**: Snow showers. Low around 16. Southwest wind around 16 mph, with gusts as high as 25 mph. Chance of precipitation is 90%. New snow accumulation of 3 to 7 inches possible.

**New Year's Day**: A 30 percent chance of snow showers before 11am. Mostly sunny, with a high near 26. West wind 13 to 16 mph becoming north in the afternoon. Winds could gust as high as 25 mph. New snow accumulation of less than a half inch possible.


**Saturday Night**: Clear, with a low around 6. North wind 8 to 16 mph, with gusts as high as 26 mph.

**Sunday**: Sunny, with a high near 37. Northeast wind 6 to 8 mph.

Sunday Night: Mostly clear, with a low around 15. Northeast wind around 5 mph becoming

light and variable.

**Monday**: Sunny, with a high near 43. Light southeast wind becoming south 5 to 9 mph in the morning. Winds could gust as high as 15 mph.
