Happy New Year! What better time to make some changes to our Forest Lakes News E-blasts than at the start of a new year.

Research has shown that you, the recipient, spend about two seconds looking at an email to decide if you want to keep reading. You want them kept as short as possible. You are okay with receiving emails more often, but with less content. (I've probably already lost your attention - my 2 seconds are up!)

With that in mind, here is what our new E-blasts will look like:

- 1. The Subject line will always say "Forest Lakes News for (date)" The date will be repeated at the top of the Email.
- 2. When you open your Email, there will be a list of Contents. For example:

- Green
 Waste
 Transfer
 Station
 Will
 be
 Open
 Saturday
- FL Fire Station Remains Closed
- A Reminder of Verizon

3. E-blasts will be sent more frequently with less content. No more monthly "Happenings" but you will get the same amount of news.

Put the above phone number in your Contacts list. Please keep in mind that even though the Verizon tower is on leased property from the Fire District, the fire personnel are NOT the ones to call to report any issues.
