When we have guests or let someone use our cabin without us being with them, they don't know our few "Do's and Don'ts". You can print out this list and put it on your refrigerator or somewhere for all to see.

### 1. Regarding

until early Wednesday morning, the pick up day. Make sure the lid closes and bags are not hanging over the side. Your garbage is an invitation for birds, nocturnal animals, and bears to have а feast! Also, when it gets put out and you leave, you don't realize how unsightly it is if it gets dumped and

broken open. 2. Regarding pets \_ Control and leash them at all times. Not only is it the law, but it keeps them from getting lost and safe from wildlife. Please keep them quiet between the hours of 10 РМ and 6 AM, and keep indoors if they excessively bark. You might not mind it, but your neighbor does.

3. Respect quiet hours from 10 PMto 6 AM. Everyone appreciates and deserves а good nights' sleep. Be mindful of playing late night music. Don't trespass on private properties. Unless
