You can print out this list and put it on your refrigerator or somewhere for all to see.

1. Regarding trash
–
if you contract with Larson Waste for trash pick-up, please do not put your dumpster at the curb

until
early
Wednesday
morning,
the
pick
up
day.
Make
sure
the
lid
closes
and
bags
are
not
hanging
over
the
side.
Your
garbage
is
an
invitation
for
birds,
nocturnal
animals,
and
bears
to
have
a
feast!
Also,
when
it
gets
put
out
and
you
leave,
you
don't
realize
how
unsightly
it
is
if
it
gets
dumped
and
bags

broken
open.

2. Regarding
pets

–

Control
and
leash
them
at
all
times.

Not
only
is
it
the
law,
but
it
keeps
them
from
getting
lost
and
safe
from
wildlife.

Please
keep
them
quiet
between
the
hours
of

10
PM
and
6

AM,
and
keep
indoors
if

they
excessively
bark.

You
might
not
mind
it,
but
your
neighbor
does.

3. Respect quiet hours from 10 PM to 6 AM. Everyone appreciates and deserves a good night's sleep. Be mindful of playing late night music. remove
anything
from
a
private
property.
That
is
stealing
and
punishable
by
law.
That
includes
rocks,
plants,
wood,
etc.
If
you
see
something
on
a
property
that
might
look
like
it's
just

part
of
the
property,
please
ask
if
the
owner
would
want
to
part
with
it
before
you
just
take
it.

6. Drive
cautiously
on
roads
and
observe
posted
speed
limits.
Obey
the
law.

control.

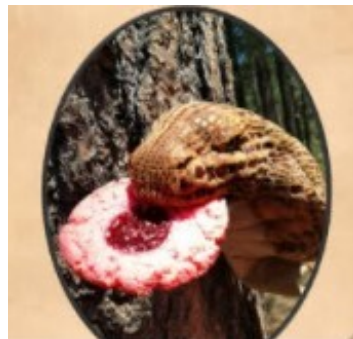
