## **EDITOR'S REPORT**

### **BUSH FIRE INFORMATION**

Most of you are already aware of the Bush Fire that is burning in the Four Peaks Wilderness Area. There is no risk of fire in Forest Lakes due to it, but smoke and ash has been present since Sunday evening and could continue for several days. Anyone with respiratory/health related issues should consider whether they should be in Forest Lakes at this time.

As of this morning (June 15th), the Bush Fire is now over 30,000 acres. Tonto Basin and Punkin Center are being evacuated and Jake's Corner and Sunflower are on pre-evacuation notice.

Highway 87 is completely shut down at the Mazatzal Casino in Payson. NO ONE will get through. Hwy 188 is closed down and only being used as a evacuation route. Access to Forest Lakes from Phoenix or vice versa is to use I-17 North to Camp Verde exit, then to Payson and Hwy 260 to Forest Lakes, or US 60 East to Globe, then North to Show Low and back East on HWY 260 to Forest Lakes. For up to date information on highway conditions and closures, follow 511 on your cell phone.

Reports from local residents are regularly posted on the FOREST LAKES BULLETIN BOARD or the FOREST LAKES COMMUNITY SOCIAL SPOT pages on Facebook. A good way to keep in touch with "what's happening now".

Tuesday and Wednesday due to the continuing water line construction.


