Oct. 9, 1827

"Died in Greenacastle on Sat. morn. last in the 74th year of her age, Mrs. Mary Holliday, relict of Major John Holliday, late of this borough. The remains of this respectable and esteemed lady were brought here on Sunday last agreeably to her own desire and deposited in the graveyard of Mr. Denny's church along side of those of her husband."

"Yesterday between 12 and 1 o'clock, departed this life, Major John Holliday, one of the Magistrates of this borough, in the 66th year of his age, after a short illness. On the eve of the 5th inst. he was seized with a severe chill, which was succeeded by a fever, which baffled all the skill of his physicians.

The character of this good man comprehended in it so many points of excellence, that only a very imperfect outline can be here given.
