II. The Challenge:

Lewis sought out Vocal Rogue CIC's 'Well-being Check-In' service as he battled persistent mental health challenges compounded by physical ailments that hindered his daily life and aspirations. Although he had a natural talent for carpentry and a strong desire to be self-employed, he felt overwhelmed by numerous obstacles.

After years in CRM work, mental health issues and physical health struggles sidelined him, but woodworking became his refuge. His passion shone through in beautifully crafted pieces like a shamisen and a custom table, reflecting his skill. However, low self-esteem and anxiety hindered his ability to network and market himself. Additionally, he lacked the know-how and resources to develop a viable business plan.
