Lesson #2: I Need Help

The storms come crashing into our lives. In these uncertain moments, Jesus extends this simple invitation: "Bring your problems to me."

Read Philipians 4:6-7 Matthew 20:29-34

Key points:

- God delights when we say we need help.
- If we could do it on our own, then there was no reason for Jesus to die for our sins
- The moment you sense a problem, however large or small... Take it to Jesus
- God may be using your struggles to change you
- God keeps his word. We just need to ask.

Discussion questions:

- 1. Why is it so hard for us to ask for help?
- 2. Discuss a time when a "red engine light" came on in your life and the only option you had was to pray.
- 3. Where do we tend to take our problems rather than bringing them to Jesus, trusting him and then leaving them there?
- 4. Talk about an answered prayer that was specific, shocking and faith building.
