Funds will be used to purchase items such as crafting supplies; paper products for meals; added cleaning supplies to meet COVID cleaning each evening.</p>	<p><u>Monday is for Donors-by appointment 9:00a to 11:00a</u> <u>Tuesday is for guests to pick up pantry boxes.</u></p> <p><i><u>Donors and clients</u></i> are asked to call 410-885-3244 on Thursday or Friday mornings (9:00a to Noon) to schedule an appointment to drop off donations the following Monday (for donors) or Tuesdays to pick up a pantry box. Since we operate solely with volunteers, appointments enable us to determine how many volunteers and how many hours are needed each week.</p> <p><u>PARTNERING MINISTRY –“Wee Care Boxes”</u> We have been operating a new feeding ministry in partnership with Chesapeake City Elementary School. The “wee care” boxes are mini-pantry boxes-filled with 3-5 lunch/lite dinner type meals geared towards younger children’s tastes. We also include a mini-personal care bag. YOU CAN HAVE NEW & ABUNDANT LIFE!

Jesus said, "*The time has come. . . The kingdom of God is near. Repent and believe the good news!*" (Mark 1:15 NIV)

And again, "*I have come so that they may have life, and have it more abundantly.*" (John 10:10)

That includes you!

As recorded in John 3:16, "*For God so loved the world, he gave his only begotten Son, that whoever believes in him may have eternal life.*"

To have that abundant and eternal life simply, "Repent" or "turn" to God and believe the good news of Jesus Christ. You can do this in your heart by asking God's forgiveness of your sins (thoughts and actions which separate you from God's love and holiness).
