Again the ultimate goal is to provide the expectant Moms with the most current information and best services available."

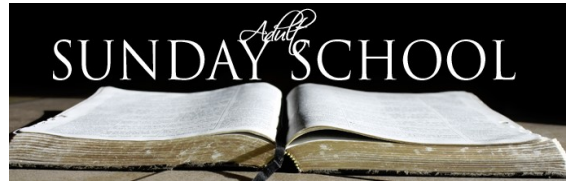
