
Tom and Alison Duffy will be collecting toys again this year!

- Masks must be carried for all guests age 3+ and must be worn when in close proximity with persons outside their household. At an event like the bonfire, this likely means wearing a mask for large portions of the event.
- For the safety of all guests and staff, guests unwilling to follow stated rules and policies and/or requests of staff may be asked to leave at any time.

And again, "I have come so that they may have life, and have it more abundantly." (John 10:10)
