Dear Redner Receipts participants,

Following these guidelines can help ensure that your organization (CCEA) will receive their checks in a timely manner.

- Customer must use their Pump Perks/1% Save-A-Tape card for purchase. This will be noted on the bottom of the receipt.
- Please submit the whole receipt. Partial receipts will not be considered.
- Please do not use a highlighter marker on your receipts, it can erase the totals.
- All receipts must be dated within one year prior to the date of submission.
- Receipts from fuel purchases at Redner's Quick Shoppes are not considered.

Money earned through this program helps to fund the CCEA food pantry in purchasing perishable and non-perishable food.

Many of you see the announcement for Redner's each month. With most of our churches currently closed to weekly worship, the receipts being turned in has decreased. On average these receipts produce an additional \$1000.00+ annually in funding to the Food Pantry.

As noted in the announcement you must use your Rewards Card at the register and tapes may not be altered in any way (please do not cut; mark up, etc.) and the date of the tape must be within the last 12 months (we highly recommend 9 months or less to ensure they are still good by the time we receive and process them). The simple act of using your card, saving your tapes and sending them in makes more difference than you realize when the tapes are added to the others received.

Greetings Friends,

Pastor Sam here, I greet you all in the wonderful name of our Savior and friend Jesus Christ. I pray that you are all safe and well at the beginning of what looks to be a beautiful summer in Chesapeake City.

Walking around town and talking to folks on these beautiful, almost-summer days one can almost feel in the air the change that is occurring. A change not just of the seasons, but in our lives, in our churches, and in our community as a whole. After thinking on this, one piece of scripture that I've been drawn to at this changing of the seasons is Ezekiel chapter 37, the valley of dry bones. In this familiar scene from scripture, the prophet Ezekiel witnesses a vision of a valley covered with dry bones. A scene of complete desolation and hopelessness, a place from which life could surely never blossom. But then God, the one who gives and receives all life, moves and breathes into the dry bones and life flourishes again.

Over the course of the last year, we have seen the stresses of COVID create in our lives, our churches, our community, our nation, and world: many places that resemble the valley of dry bones (physically, emotionally, mentally, or spiritually). Over the course of the last year, we have seen COVID reveal to us many places in our lives, churches, communities, nation, and world that were already valleys of dry bones, simply made more obvious. But at the turning of the seasons, at the beginning of something new, we of the faith remember that even the driest valley can be made alive again through the one who first gave and continues to give life to all.

God, the Lord of life, has witnessed the dryness of our lives, churches, community, and world. He calls out to us the question given to Ezekiel: "Son of man, can these bones live"? Of course, God knows the answer to this question because God is the answer to this question. The true test is whether we as people of faith will choose to come together and recognize that God is the true source of all our life. The true test is whether we will realize that even the spots of life that feel like valleys of dry bones can be made new and alive through the power and grace of God. The true test is whether we join with Him in the effort to recreate the world around us in life and love.

As we go into the summer months, let us always be aware and attentive to who it is that is bringing about the newness, the joy, the love, and the life blossoming around us. Most of all, let us join in the blessed efforts taking place within us and within our






