Pastor Sam here, I pray that the beginning of spring is treating each of you well and you are not too troubled by allergies and pollen to enjoy the blooming of God's creation. I am always amazed at the fresh beauty God unveils during the springtime, and this year

This year the month of May ends with one of the greatest celebrations of the Christian year, that of Pentecost. This is a Sunday where we commemorate the sending of the Holy Spirit upon the apostles and the leaders of the early church, and pray for God to do the same for us the Church of today in a new way. This time between Easter Sunday and Pentecost centers itself on the creation of the Church, which is brought into its fullness on Pentecost itself. Considering the theme of this season my mind is drawn to the familiar words of Jesus teaching on the true vine from John 15: 1-4

"I am the true vine, and my Father is the gardener. He cuts off every branch in me that bears no fruit, while every branch that does bear fruit he prunes so that it will be even more fruitful. As we look forward to the celebration of the creation of the church, the Body of Christ in this world, we must also be attentive to ways that we can continue to participate in that same Body.
