An Asbury Shorts USA produced event is generally a one-night screening of award winning short films from the past and present. Fast paced and non competitive the 2 hour showcase would feature Oscar nominees and winners, "Best of Show" and "Audience Favorites" from US film festivals and international honorees specially chosen from the world's top film festivals, providing the attendees a rare opportunity to view world renowned shorts on a real cinema screen as opposed to You Tube, smart phones and computers.
