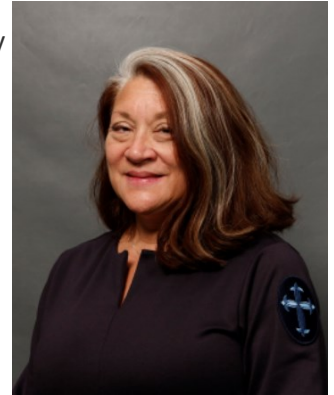

“Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who promised is faithful. And let us consider how to stir up one another in love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.”

Hebrews 10:23-25

It is important for young adults to be grounded in their Christian faith. They face many challenges as they begin to move into the adult world during their time at university and they often have no connection to a welcoming, similarly-minded Christian group while they are away from home. There are fewer opportunities to meet other Christians, especially Lutheran Christians, in our increasingly online world. The faith of these young people can be challenged by new situations. Their need for grounding in the Word of God is crucial. There is a need to learn to defend one's faith (apologetics) in the realms of self, school, and workplace.

There is no official Lutheran presence at any of the local universities (UW-GB, St. Norbert, Bellin, and NWTTC). Synod's organization, LCMS-U, is designed to be that presence in the lives of university-aged students.

“The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod's Campus Ministry works through LCMS U, an initiative to connect and support Lutheran students as they head off to college and face countless challenges to their biblical worldview, doctrine, ethics and practices.” (LCMS.org) The Synod offers theological resources to establish and maintain such an organization.

Faith Lutheran can be a significant part of this outreach. We already have young adults—single or married – choosing to attend Divine service or join our congregation. Our congregation needs to serve our neighbors in the community and offer them the confidence of faith and friends. This outreach will connect them to God’s Word and Sacraments, and to each other.
