NEW BANNERS

Two new banners are being introduced today. One contains the very familiar imagery of Noah and the ark. This story from Genesis teaches us of God's mercy as he saves Noah and his family, eight souls in all, from the destruction of the earth. Through Noah, God preserves his creation in anticipation of its salvation through Noah's descendant, Jesus. The rainbow is the symbol of God's promise that never again will he destroy the earth in a flood.

The second banner contains imagery less familiar to many Christians. Beginning in the Second Century, the image, known as "a pelican in her piety," became a picture used to teach the church about the sacrifice of Christ. Legends in the ancient world taught that a mother pelican, during a time of famine, would pluck her feathers and pierce her breast in order to feed her chicks, sacrificing her life for the sake of her children. This picture of sacrifice reminds us of Christ on the cross who was pierced and bled for the sake of the children of God. He gives us his body and blood that we might have life everlasting.

Thank you to the dedicated women who make these banners for our congregation. Your work is a blessing to us all.


HELP MOVING
