SUMMER SERMON SERIES

Week 1: St. Paul's letter to the Ephesians, written near the end of Paul's life in 60 AD, serves as the "crown of Pauline thought." In this letter, sent to the congregation where he lived for three years of his life and where St. John and Jesus' mother, Mary, would eventually live as well, Paul beautifully describes the Christian faith. He begins by teaching how God has chosen you, in Christ, to be his child. Then, after celebrating the work of the Gospel and the gifts of baptism, he teaches the Christians how their lives have been transformed by the work of God. From now through Labor Day, Paul's teachings will be the focus of the weekly sermon and Tuesday morning Bible study as we hear Paul's confession of faith together.

More about Ephesus: Ephesus is located on the western edge of Turkey, connected by a river to the Aegean Sea. Founded in 1400 BC, it was a major center of trade in the Roman Empire and was likely the third largest Roman city at the time of Paul. Scholars estimate that at the height of its influence, the city population was 250,000 people.
