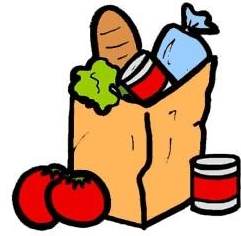


Faith Lutheran Church was recognized at the World Refugee Day Event
