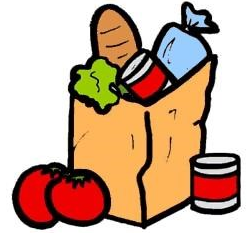

He has no food allergies and he considers himself a bit of a food nut :)

Food

- Nuts (pistachios, walnuts, peanuts, etc.)
