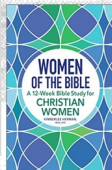

ORGAN RECITAL

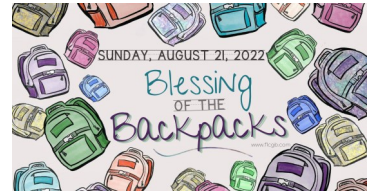

WOMEN'S BIBLE STUDY

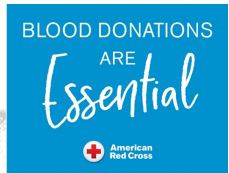
